TECH. TALK.

Do you know why our swivels are wrapped in black plastic?

Storm Plastics brand is the only Swivels in Australia made of PVC and have an expansion component as part of the swivel.

To allow that expansion to happen there is a rubber ring for that section to slide and there is another rubber ring to allow the swivel or knuckle function to happen.

Two rubber rings, very close together in one fitting would be like Christmas for tree roots if we didn't sprinkle a small amount of Copper Sulphate crystals around the possible entry point to prevent tree root intrusion **and the black plastic is there to protect the crystals during transport and handling.**

All Storm Plastics Swivels are treated this way as they are designed for underground use. Our Expandas are not all wrapped as some are used on stacks so you can have them plain, already taped or buy the tape and wrap them yourself.

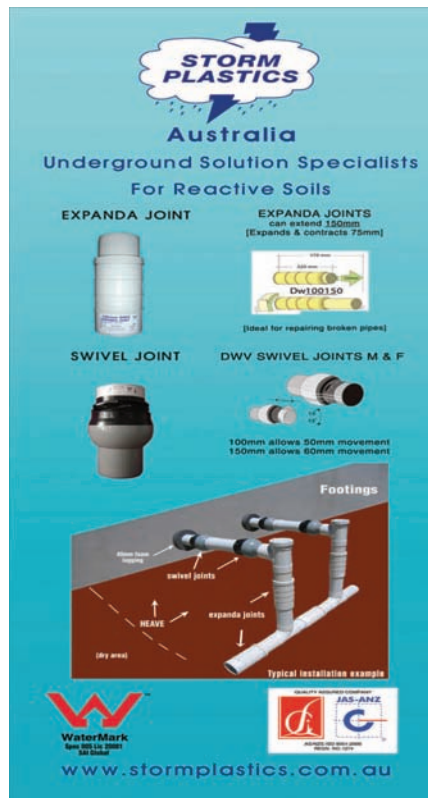
