Storm Plastics demonstrate their dedication and commitment to the environment by recycling plastic packaging and cardboard material during production as well as offering customers "End of Life Product Recycling" of Storm Plastics PVC products.

Storm Plastics offers extended supplier responsibility (take-back arrangements) to customers to recycle any Storm Plastics PVC products as well as contractual agreements with customers if required.

Once Storm Plastics receives the used PVC products for recycling it is then forwarded on to Precimax Plastics Pty Ltd 37 Watervale Drive Greenfields SA 5107.

Precimax Plastics have signed an agreement that states: "We can confirm that Storm ridged PVC fittings returned to Storm from all sources for recycling, may be forwarded on to Precimax Plastics Pty Limited for the purpose of recycling. This process will ensure the life cycle of material is extended in line with our environmental policy & responsibilities".
